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Action On Stage Activities And

Action involves the most overt behavioural changes and requires considerable commitment of time and energy. Behavioural changes in the action stage tend to be most visible and externally recognised. Individuals are classified in the action stage if they have successfully altered the dysfunctional behaviour for a period from one day to six months.

Activities for the Forming Stage Get acquainted and community building activities are used here to form the atmosphere of safety and acceptance. There are a few more activities suggested in this stage because it is important to build a strong foundation if the rest of the stages are to be successfully navigated.

If appropriate, the activities could be used to support an intervention program. During the Action stage, when people are working to strengthen their commitment to the change, external support is critical, says Prochaska. Even though they may not be inclined to ask for it, people in this stage benefit from offers of emotional and physical support, and from having people around them recognize their progress and help keep them accountable.
