Hyakki Yagyō, variation: Hyakki Yakō, (百鬼夜行, "Night Parade of One Hundred Demons") is an idiom in Japanese folklore. Sometimes an orderly procession, other times a riot, it refers to an uncontrolled horde of countless numbers of supernatural creatures known as oni and yōkai.

Numerous scrolls of the Night Parade of One Hundred Demons have been produced since the Muromachi period. Their prototype is the scroll Tsukumogami (literally, "god of transformed things"). The premise of these scrolls is that everything, even worn-out kitchen utensils, must be disposed of respectfully and according to ritual, or their spirits will not be at rest.
